**PHILADELPHIA** – The Pennsylvania Horticultural Society’s celebration of the season, **PHeaSt**, moves to the Pop Up Garden at uCity Square at 36<sup>th</sup> and Filbert Streets this year for an enchanting evening under the harvest moon on Friday, October 12, from 7 to 10 p.m.

Set in a whimsical apple orchard, the 7<sup>th</sup> annual PHeaSt will feature a spread of delicious food from local restaurants and artisans and handcrafted cocktails inspired by the season’s bountiful harvest. Live music will enliven the evening along with a few surprises to entertain guests in this beautiful garden setting.

Benefactor ticket holders will be treated to a VIP experience starting at 6 p.m. as well as free valet parking. Additionally, the Jose Pistola’s Group will infuse their creative flair into an array of passed hors d’oeuvres and an oyster shucking station, all accompanied by the delightful sounds of a live jazz trio.

Philadelphia’s blossoming culinary scene will be well represented at PHeaSt as chefs from across the city provide mouthwatering highlights from their menus. Featured restaurants will include **CO-OP Restaurant & Lounge**, **Eatable Delights Catering**, **Goldie**, **Jose Pistola’s**, **Red Owl Tavern**, **Square 1682**, and **Townsend**, with more to be announced over the next few weeks.

Mixologists will infuse the bold flavors of the season into the evening’s specialty cocktails, featuring **Ketel One Botanicals** and **Crown Royal Regal Apple**. The variety of plates, both savory and sweet, will be beautifully paired with a selection of craft beer and wines from local producers.
